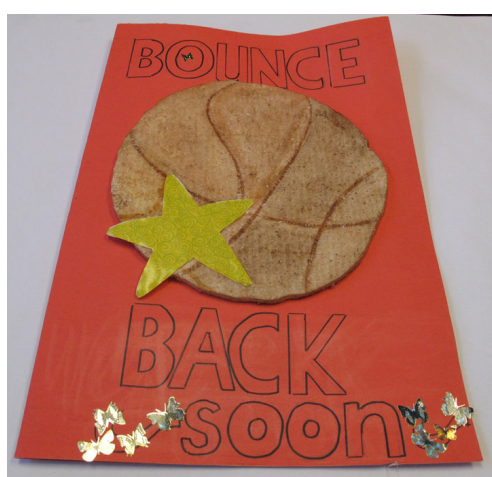
Eufemia, Frank '70 (Pembroke Pines, FL) – recently celebrated 39 years of marriage with his wife, Barbara.

Indoor Track



Congratulations to the boys and girls Varsity Track and Field team. They ended their indoor season with a lot of great performances. On the boys side, the team was led by Senior, Sidney Gibbons (pictured above) who won gold in the 55 meter high hurdles at the City championships. He is now a 3 time City Champion! During the trials of the 55 hurdles Sid broke the old meet record of 7.60 with a 7.56. Sidney will now focus his attention and compete at the New York State Federation Championships in March, which is the best of the best in public and private high schools in all of New York.

Sophomore Quentin Holmes ranked 9th going into the meet came up big and placed 5th in 55 meter dash. He could join Sidney as an alternate in the 55 meter dash at the state championships.

The girls team was led by Freshman Clodagh Moyles who ran a personal best in the mile run, Sophomores Tori Ramirez who had a personal best in the shot put, and Sophomore, Gabby Sikorski who had a personal best in the 55 meter dash.

Eight out of 10 girls qualified for A Championships and finished 9th out of 10 schools.

Niamh Rattigan became City B Champion in 100M Breast stroke.

The Boys qualified for the finals in the 200M Medley Relay and 400M Freestyle Relay.

The Boys Novices finished 10th out 15 schools.

Bowling

(from The Fall Season)

Both the Varsity and Junior Varsity teams finished the regular seasons being tied for fourth place in the league. The Varsity finished 52-25 (point scoring), and the Junior Varsity (47-30). Both teams, however, lost the tiebreaker (total pins) and officially finished in fifth place. League rules require that the one to four teams play for the "A" and city championship, and the five to eight teams play for the "B" championship. Both teams won the first game of the "B" playoffs but lost the championship game.

The Varsity team was led by Julian Tablante with a 204 average, second best in the league and only one point behind the leader. The Junior Varsity was led by Mark Casselli with a 129 average.
