Thomas J. Principe '65 has been reappointed to **The Mayor's Advisory Committee On The Judiciary**. The Committee recruits, screens, and nominates highly qualified candidates for judicial appointment to the Family Court and Criminal Court of New York City, as well as the Civil Court for an interim appointment. Based on the Committee's nominations, the Mayor makes appointments to these courts. The Committee also evaluates incumbent judges for reappointment to these courts and submits its recommendations to the Mayor. Mr. Principe was first appointed to the Committee in 2014. Tom has been a partner at Kramer, Dillof, Livingston & Moore in Manhattan since 1989 representing injured persons in personal injury and medical malpractice law suits.
