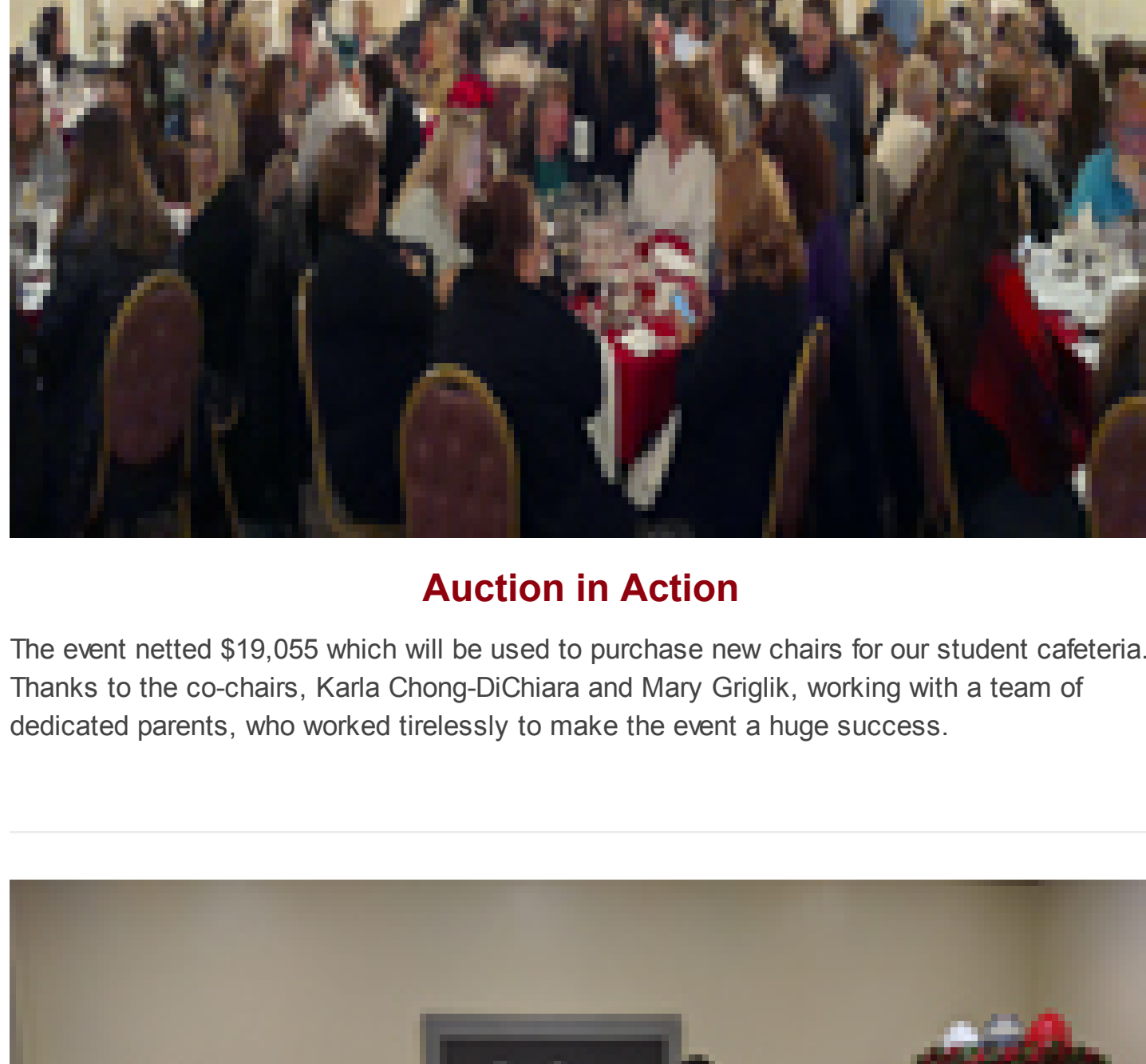
## Eucharistic Minister Commissioning

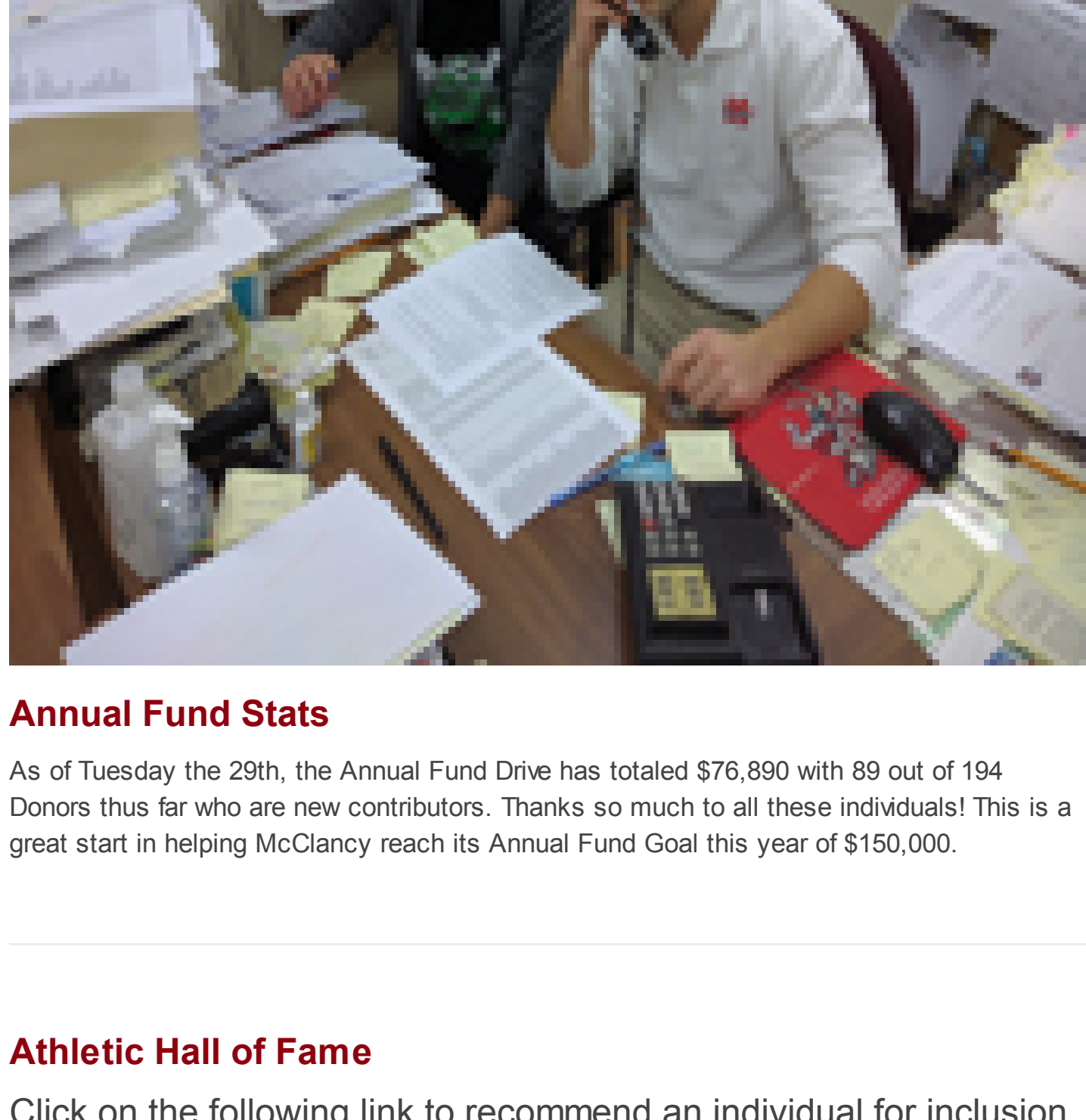
## Auction in Action

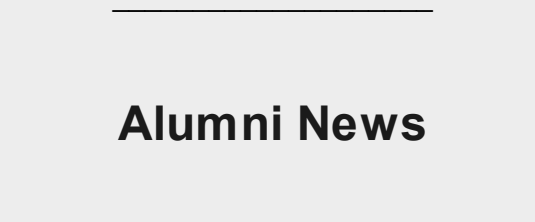
## Annual Fund Stats

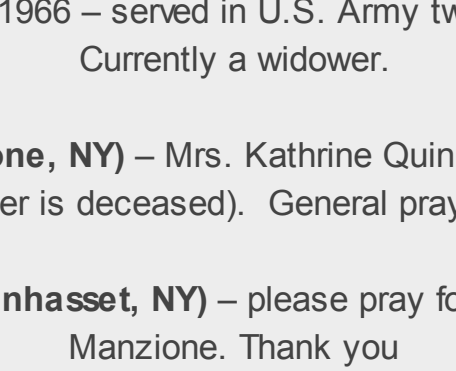

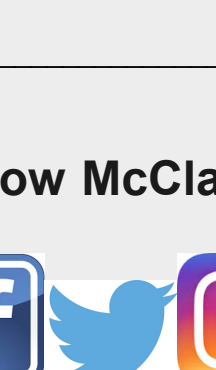
