



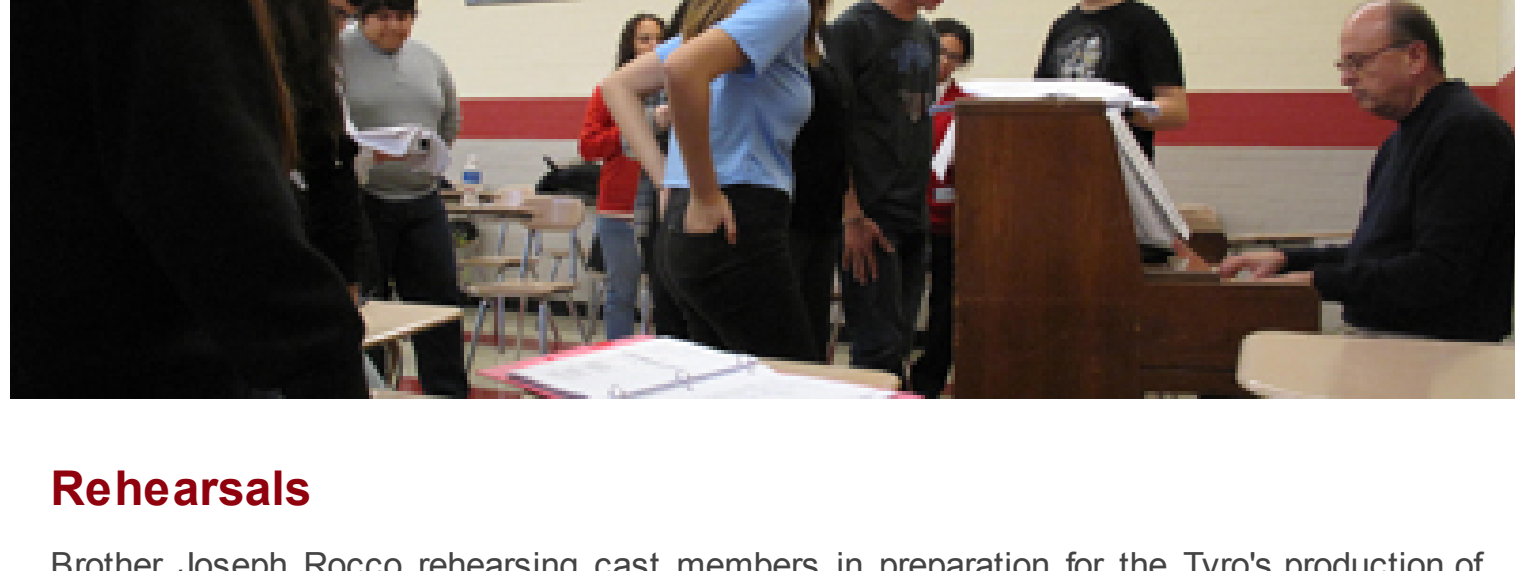

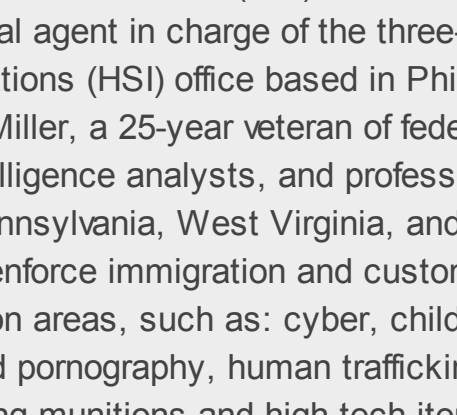

HSI special agents protect national security and enforce immigration and customs laws by conducting criminal investigations in various mission areas, such as: cyber, child exploitation including child sex tourism and possessing child pornography, human trafficking, intellectual property rights, drug smuggling, illegal exporting munitions and high-tech items, money laundering, financial crimes, transnational gangs.

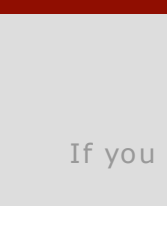
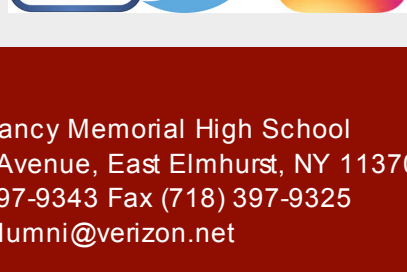
Baynes, Leonard '75 (Houston, TX) – In August 2014, I became Dean of University of Houston Law Center.
