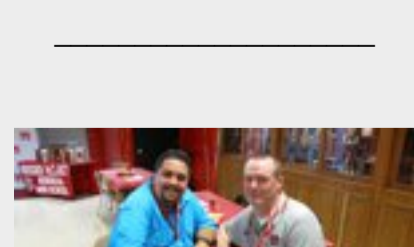

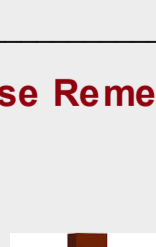
Thanks to the 59 alumni + 18 wives, guests, and faculty who were able to attend.

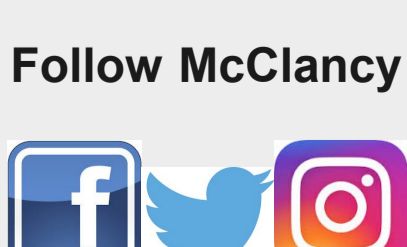
