### Mission Trip 2017

Pictured above are **150** students from all **9** US schools conducted in the *educational tradition of the Brothers of the Sacred Heart* who gathered in Houma, Louisiana for a mission trip hosted by Vanderbilt Catholic and E.D. White HS. **19** students attended from McClancy. The participants did service work in four locations for the **United Houma Nation**. The students worked 4 days from 7:30 to 11:00 AM. They chopped down trees, cleared paths, scrapped walls, repaired buildings, cleaned underbrush, painted walls, and tore down a barn (see pictures below). In the afternoons, they toured the bayous. In the evenings, they learned about the local culture, shared prayer, and reflected on their experiences.

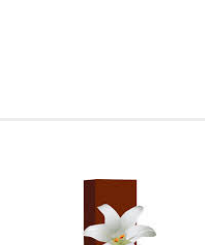

Fred retired some years ago after 40 years in the financial services industry, having served in senior management capacities in community and regional banks in New York and New Jersey.

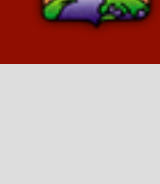
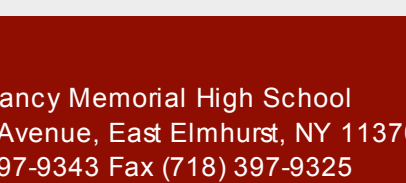
For the past 12 years Fred has filled his days as President/Executive Director of the Paramus Regional Chamber of Commerce.
