Manhattan College recently honored **Stephen J. Squeri, McClancy Class of 1977**, with the **De La Salle Medal** at its annual Gala Dinner. Steve is an AmEx Vice Chairman and Manhattan College Graduate, '81 and '86 (MBA).

The De La Salle Medal Dinner was established by Manhattan College in 1951 in honor of Saint John Baptist de La Salle, founder of the Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools and patron saint of teachers. Since 1977, the College's board of trustees has viewed the dinner as an opportunity to honor executives who exemplify the principles of excellence and corporate leadership.

The De La Salle Medal Dinner raises essential funds for student scholarships and financial aid, making a Manhattan College education accessible for more students.
