Please remember Brother Aidan Curtin who passed away in Queens, New York at Ozanam Hall Nursing Home. He was just shy of his 84th birthday and was in his 63rd year of religious profession as a Brother of the Sacred Heart. Brother Aidan received a B.A. in Secondary Education and English from Spring Hill College, Mobile, Alabama; and a M.A. in Educational Counseling from Seton Hall University, South Orange, New Jersey.

Brother Aidan served in several schools during a period spanning 42 years: St. Philip Neri Elementary School, Bronx, NY; Msgr. McClancy Memorial High School, Queens, NY; St. Joseph High School, Metuchen, NJ; Bishop Reilly High School, Queens, NY; and St. Luke Elementary School, Bronx, NY. During his long tenure at McClancy, Brother Aidan was instrumental in the success of its track program; and after retiring from the classroom at McClancy in 1999, he remained active in several support roles at the school.

Brother was laid to rest in the Brothers' Cemetery in Metuchen, New Jersey.
